

## Communications Committee Minutes 8/3/04

In attendance: Stan Solow, Gina Mushynsky, Mary Mulligan, Rosemary DeVito, Jack Krisanda.

1. Discussion on Post Office bulk mailing project. The project is on indefinite hold due to the projected cost of mailing the *Reflections* to apartment and condo residents. The committee will continue to work on improving delivery to the apartments/condos.
2. Jack directed Gina to hand-deliver small numbers of the *Reflections* to every Corporate Park business. Most of the businesses will receive five copies; larger businesses will receive 20 to start. This is in addition to the five copies she delivers to the Baldwinsville Public Library and the 20 copies she delivers to Cottage Restaurant.
3. Ned Goetzke has been on vacation. When he returns, Stan will approach him about putting an article on this year's elections/proposition vote results in the *Reflections*.
4. Gina finished and distributed first drafts of the *Reflections* policy re-write to those present. The committee will review the draft version and discuss at the next meeting.
5. Gina is halfway finished with the Governmental Liaison subcommittee assignment (assemble a reference document listing all elected/appointed personnel of local, county, state and federal legislatures, etc.; and business associations and groups whose activities affect the Radisson community).
6. Jack would like biographies and photos of all Board members on the website and in the *Reflections* by September. Gina will compose a standardized, "fill in the blank" sheet for board members to fill out and return to her for September publication.
7. Stan reported that there is one new member of the Governmental Liaison subcommittee, bringing the total to seven.
8. Stan and Gina will work together to compose an article on the Operations Committee for the *Reflections*.
9. Julie has added a "click here to join our newsgroup" button to the website.
10. Residents have been using the newsgroup for general conversation among themselves in recent weeks. Many members complained of getting so many e-mails of general conversation instead of special notices from the RCA Office. Some members have expressed gratitude for the newsgroup's existence.
10. The "Get Involved" volunteer sign-up sheet will run in the 8/18 *Reflections*. This is critical.
