B’VILLE COMMUNITY BAND CONCERT

Wednesday, June 7th from 7-8pm at Lake Oberon, rain location of Aspen House. No one is available to serve refreshments so Liz will work this one. The next concert is scheduled for Wednesday, August 16th.

ANNUAL LUAU

We have reserved Brett Maring of Professional Sounds of CNY to DJ for the event. He is younger, worked the Teen Pool Parties last summer and did a spectacular job. Liz will confirm with him that he has “The Limbo.” Everyone agreed that we should cut back on the amount of pork we order, Liz will make contact with Denny Morgan of Mountainview Restaurant this week. Liz has contacted Ryan Brown of AB to see if they will be donating kegs as usual – she hasn’t heard back yet. 4 kegs should be good. Liz has placed a request to Moyers Corners for a donation of wine. Sue, Elaine, Adel and Cathy will be available to help. The pool will close at 3:30pm, volunteers should arrive between 3:30-4:00pm. We will make sure we have more Christmas lights (for the trellis) and more lights on the food. Elaine suggested lanterns on the table – Lesa will look for some. Liz will have the guards fill the luminary bags. We will have a 50/50 raffle to benefit Relay for Life. Liz and Lesa will meet up later in the month in regards to paper products and anything else needed. Liz will make sure we have guards to work that night and the security is all set.

SSO UPDATE

So far we have raised just over \$500 in personal donations. Liz got a \$3000 grant from Senator DeFrancisco. We will get bouncies as usual. Cathy will look into a clown and Sue will look into a stilt performer. Liz will

give a reminder to the BOD that we desperately need volunteers for Founder's. Liz will secure Sue Campenella & Peter Sperlazza for the event as well as Agenda. Everyone is in agreement that we would love to have The Shift back. Liz will contact Bob Feduik to see if he has any ideas on how to work The Shift in – we would like them to play sometime during 12-4 but how can we work that we Agenda? Lesa reminded us that we will need a canopy over the stage for Agenda this year, we will look into that. Liz will also contact the Fire Department, the Sheriff's and possibly the Army to come.

MISCELLANEOUS

Lynn Gebhardt, a resident, contacted Liz about trying to start up a 4th of July bike parade – children could decorate bikes and maybe start at Kerri, do a loop then return to Kerri for refreshments. Everyone agrees this is a great idea and something we would love to see happen. Unfortunately with the short time frame it isn't something that could be done for this 4th of July. Others suggested maybe doing it at the end of the summer because besides the fact that it couldn't be planned in time many people go away for 4th of July. Liz will contact Lynn and see if she would be interested in planning it for the end of the summer, maybe tying it in with a B'ville Community Band concert or something like that.

Liz will contact Larry from Cucina di Amore in regards to setting up a Comedy Dinner for either 10/13 or 10/14. She will get the info on the menu, price, deposit, cancel window, drink prices, etc. Elaine suggested trying to set up a carpool for local seniors.

Elaine will contact Mike Chapman from the Ice Arena to try and set up a skating party for 8/8 or 8/9 in the evening. Liz will talk to Courtney to see if this is something the Rec counselors could be involved in. It could also be advertised during Rec as well as in the Reflections.

Liz will also look into arranging salsa dance lessons in the Aspen House for the fall.

Since our next meeting would fall on the 4th of July we will switch it to Thursday, July 6th at 7pm at the RCA.
